This memorial scholarship is in honor of Dick Dahlgard (1935-2008), a distinguished Highline Alumni from the class of 1954. Known as "Mr. Burien" and Dick was the owner of Dick's Cameras, a well-loved local business and was named Highline High School Alumni of the year for his many contributions to the community. He was an avid philanthropist and community volunteer who dedicating much of his time and money to many community activities, which included:

Highline High School Alumni Foundation, Highline Historical Society, Highline Medical Center Foundation, the Hi-Liners, Discover Burien, Merchants of Burien, Burien Fourth of July Parade, Miss Burien Scholarship Pageant, and the Burien-White Center Rotary Club.

- 2. The applicant must have maintained a minimum 3.0 grade point average in these photography-related classes and at least a 2.5 grade point average overall.
- While preference will be given to students who choose to pursue photography or pursue a career in Digital Media or Photography, this is not an absolute requirement.

Application Procedure:

- 1. Completion of the attached two-page information sheets.
- 2. Inclusion of an unofficial transcript.
- 3. Applicant must submit a portfolio of work (printed or web-based accepted)

If you are selected for this scholarship, you must: (1) attend the Scholarship Reception, (2) write a thank you card (3) submit your Scholarship Financial Notice on or before your graduation date and (4) Participate in the College Signing Day Assembly. Failure to do these four things will disqualify you from receiving the Scholarship.
