The Alumni Association Music Scholarship will be awarded in the amount of \$4,000.

APPLICATION CRITERIA FOR MUSIC SCHOLARSHIP

In order to apply, a student must have been enrolled in band and/or choir classes for 4 full semesters or the equivalent.

The applicant must have maintained a minimum 2.0 general grade point average in all classes taken during high school.

Preference will be given to students who indicate a commitment to pursuing higher musical education or a career in music.

Each applicant must meet the announced deadline for application by submitting all required materials on or before the designated due date.

APPLICATION PROCESS FOR MUSIC SCHOLARSHIP

Each applicant must submit the following materials on or before the deadline date:

1. Letter of Application

The letter of application should include general information about the applicant's reasons for applying, special honors or merits, musical goals, musical experiences, and musical training.

2. Résumé

The résumé should focus on art/musical background, special honors, specific training, and specific experiences.

3. Tape (Music)

Each applicant should make and submit on or before the deadline a tape presenting examples of his or her best musical performance. For both band and choir students, the tape should consist of two contrasting selections, lyrical and technical (song and dance) demonstrating either jazz or classical emphasis.

If you are selected for this scholarship, you must: (1) attend the Scholarship Reception, (2) write a thank you card (3) submit your Scholarship Financial Notice on or before your graduation date and (4) Participate in the College Signing Day Assembly. Failure to do these four things will disqualify you from receiving the Scholarship.
