- Submit two essays: 1.) write a brief statement describing his or her plans to enter the teaching or counseling profession (handwritten in cursive or print appreciated but not required) 2.) write a short essay (200 word minimum) entitled "Why I Want to Become a Teacher or Counselor.
- 4. Enroll in a 2-or 4-year college/university for the fall quarter following high school graduation.
- 5. Submit an unofficial transcript with application.
- 6. Submit a letter of recommendation from a Highline Teacher.
