

HIGHLINE HIGH SCHOOL ALUMNI FOUNDATION Gary Low Memorial Scholarship

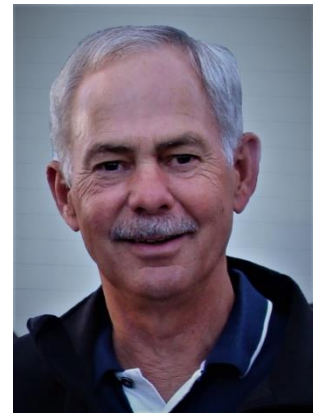
Gary W. Low graduated from Highline High School in 1967. His wife Cathy, their three daughters, and six of Gary's siblings also graduated from Highline High School.

Following high school, Gary attended Highline Community College for two years and transferred to the University of Washington where he obtained his degree in Business Administration. His first job was in the accounting department at Simpson Timber Company in downtown Seattle.

In the evenings he attended the University of Puget Sound where he earned his Masters degree.

Gary played football and basketball throughout middle school and high school. He and his brother Brian also coached a Colt League baseball team in the early 1970s. Also in the early 70s Burien had a semi-pro baseball team sponsored by Adair's Restaurant. Gary's brother-in-law was one of the coaches and asked Gary and his wife to be the official scorekeepers which they did for a few years and had a wonderful time! He was an avid Husky fan and at the 1989 Apple Cup he participated in a field goal kicking contest and won a brand new Mazda Minivan for his family! Besides the Huskies, Gary was an avid Seahawk fan and an avid golfer. He and his brother participated in the Highline High School Alumni Foundation Golf Day every year since 2000. Unfortunately in November of 2018 he suffered a fatal heart attack on the 11th hole at Auburn Golf Course.

The Alumni Foundation and the Auburn Golf Course partnered to set up a scholarship in Gary's name. With donations from board members and community members this scholarship will be awarded in the amount of \$2,000.00.

Application Criteria and Requirements:

- The applicant must plan to attend a community college, technical college, or four year Institution, public or private, in the fall quarter following high school graduation.
- An unofficial transcript must accompany the application
- Please submit a resume that outlines all school activities, volunteer work and employment.
- The applicant must submit two letters of recommendation from adults (Teachers, Coaches, Co-workers, etc.)
- Submit an essay (200 words minimum) describing your college career plans and why this particular career was chosen.
- Provide documentation of an athletic letter in sports, cheerleading, or drill (copy of Certificate or note from the Athletic Director). (special consideration given for golf athletes)

If you are selected for this scholarship you must:

1. Attend the Scholarship Reception.
 2. Write a thank you card.
 3. Submit your Scholarship Financial Notice on or before you graduation date.
 4. Participate in the College Signing Day Assembly.
- Failure to do these four things will disqualify you from receiving the Scholarship.
