This is the second annual Donald Bunger Scholarship presented by the HHS Alumni Foundation. The recipient is selected by the HHS Alumni Committee, and by Michael Walsh, sponsor of this award and HHS graduate ('77)

GENERAL STATEMENT: For students who intend to enroll in a four-year college program in one of the STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering, Mathematics) disciplines.

Mr. Bunger was an outstanding teacher at Highline High School from 1966 to 1981. In his English courses, including communication, film, graphics and yearbook, he challenged his students to be creative by integrating science and humanities. He created the Futuristics Club, whose members built models of space stations and were encouraged to think through the steps man needed to take towards the stars.

It may seem unusual to name a Technology scholarship after someone who taught in the humanities, but Mr. Bunger inspired his students to "think outside the box" on a regular basis. To be successful in the sciences requires more than numbers and facts; it requires the unusual perspective that leads to the next great discovery or the must-have product.

REQUIREMENTS FOR APPLICANTS:

- Submit a 300-word essay highlighting coursework in STEM subjects and indicate future college and career plans.
- Submit two letters of recommendation, at least one from a math or science instructor at Highline.
- Include an unofficial transcript.
- Attach a typed résumé, listing activities, hobbies, and work experience in detail.

If you are selected for this scholarship, you must: (1) attend the Scholarship Reception, (2) write a thank you card (3) submit your Scholarship Financial Notice on or before your graduation date and (4) Participate in the College Signing Day Assembly. Failure to do these four things will disqualify you from receiving the Scholarship.
